Answer: c) He doesn't like coffee.

Note: Use 'doesn't' plus base verb: 'He doesn't like coffee.'

Answer: b) exhausted

Note: 'Exhausted' means very tired.

5. Find the error: 'They was at the library yesterday.'

- a) Change 'was' to 'were'.
- b) Change 'They' to 'Them'.
- c) Remove 'yesterday'.

d) No error.

Answer: a) Change 'was' to 'were'.

Note: For plural subject 'They', use 'were': 'They were at the library yesterday.'

6. Choose the correct preposition: We will meet ____ noon.

- a) in
- b) on
- c) at
- d) by

Answer: c) at

Note: Use 'at' with precise times: 'at noon'.

7. Pick the correct question: ____ you ever been to Canada?

- a) Did
- b) Do
- c) Have
- d) Are

Answer: c) Have

Note: Present perfect question uses 'Have you ever...?'

8. Which is a synonym for 'helpful'?

- a) useful
- b) harmful
- c) careless
- d) useless

Answer: a) useful

Note: 'Useful' is a close synonym for 'helpful'.

9. Choose the best option: If it ____ tomorrow, we will cancel the picnic.

- a) rains
- b) rained
- c) is raining
- d) has rained

Answer: a) rains

Note: First conditional: If + present simple, will + base verb.

10. Select the correct form: The book was ____ by a famous author.

- a) write

- d) writing

Answer: c) written

Note: Past participle after 'was' (passive): 'was written'.

11. Fill in the blank: I prefer tea ____ coffee.

- a) than
- b) to
- c) over than
- d) with

Answer: b) to

Note: Use 'prefer A to B'.

12. Choose the correct article: She adopted ____ unusual cat.

- a) a
- b) an
- c) the
- d) no article

Answer: b) an

Note: Use 'an' before vowel sounds: 'an unusual cat'.

13. Find the correct word: Please ____ the lights when you leave.

- a) close

- d) stop

Answer: b) turn off

Note: We say 'turn off the lights'.

Answer: c) will have lived

Note: Future perfect: 'will have lived' for a duration by a future time.

Answer: c) more carefully

Note: Use 'more carefully' for comparative adverbs.

16. Choose the correct response: 'Thank you for your help.'

- a) You're welcome.

- d) I have 20 years.

Answer: a) You're welcome.

Note: 'You're welcome.' is the appropriate response.

Note: Second conditional: 'If I had... I would...'

Note: 'Interesting' fits the positive context.

20. Pick the correct sentence for a request.

- b) You to open window now.

- d) Open window now.

Answer: a) Open the window, will you?

Note: Tag question request sounds polite: 'Open the window, will you?'
